Our Strategy for Christmas Eve and Christmas Day Services

In order to bring complete clarity for our people, I want to share our strategy for our Christmas Eve and Christmas Day services. Both Christmas Eve and Christmas Day have a special place and a different role in our Christian faith. Christmas Eve provides anticipation of our Lord's birth. I liken it to being in the waiting room of a hospital looking forward to the birth of an anticipated child. Christmas Day is the day our Lord was born; therefore, it provides for us the day we celebrate the Lord's birth. As you can see, both are significant and unique experiences. Therefore, what is our strategy for Christmas Eve and Christmas Day services?

Unique and Not Identical Services

Our Christmas Eve services are **unique and not identical experiences** to the services we will offer on Christmas Day. On Christmas Eve, we will have our **Candlelight Christmas Eve services**. This will be a wonderful time of singing Christmas carols, highlighting a time for our children, hearing beautiful music, sharing a creative message unlike anything we have done before, and lighting candles. On Christmas Day, we will have our **Christmas Celebration and Communion services**. Yes, we will celebrate Christmas! Our celebration will be filled with wonderful singing of Christmas carols accompanied by beautiful music, a biblical word, offering a time for communion that families can experience together if they desire, and much more. Christmas Eve services will last an estimated forty-five minutes and Christmas Day services will last an estimated 55 minutes and absolutely no longer than an hour. In all services on Christmas Eve and Christmas Day, we will receive an offering for supporting the ministry of our church and our work globally, as we do weekly.

Offered for You to Experience the Complete Spiritual Joy of Christmas Christmas Eve and Christmas Day services are unique and not identical services offered for you to experience the complete spiritual joy of Christmas.

This is our strategy. We believe each day has its place in the Christian faith, and each day should have a special place in the life of each Christian. Therefore, we want to encourage you to come to both Christmas Eve and Christmas Day services. When you do, we believe you will experience the complete joy of Christmas.

How do we not attend a Worship Service on Christmas Day, the day we celebrate the birth of Jesus?

I pray you will join us on Christmas Day for one of our worship services. I have heard that some churches have decided to cancel services on Christmas Day. Cross Church believes that if indeed Christmas Day is about us celebrating that God has come to this earth to live among us through the birth of Jesus Christ, then we need to celebrate His birthday. Please join us. Come dressed in your normal Christmas Day apparel and bring your families and friends.

Does anyone want to be Baptized on Christmas Day?

What a terrific Christmas memory and faith memory for you to be baptized on Christmas Day! 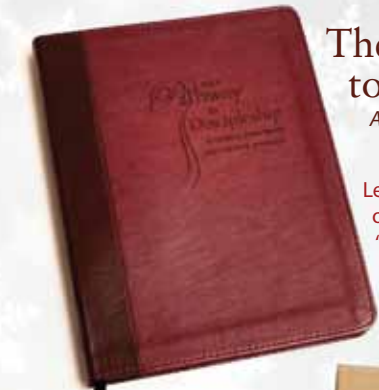
